Rule 3 in Chapter I of the rules ~~framed~~ framed under section 42 (2) of the Elementary Education Act, 1920, provides that in special cases schools recently opened which have trained teachers, the district educational councils may entertain applications for aid received on other than the prescribed dates. G.O. No. 6 Law (Edn) dated 3-1-24 further provides that the following classes of schools may be admitted to aid supplementally:-

(i). Secondary schools converted into Elementary Schools if they submit on or before the 30th April their application for aid in the year following that in which the school worked as secondary school.

(ii) Schools which, for no fault of their own, were omitted from the list received from departmental officers, if the schools are otherwise ~~eligible~~ eligible under the rules and

(iii) Schools started by students discharged

The question of giving complete discretion to District Educational Councils in the matter of admission of schools to aid supplementally was discussed in the notes to G.O. No. 396 Law (Education), dated 14-3-24, and the Hon'ble Minister has directed that the question should be taken up when the rules are next revised.
