The policy of Government is to encourage all agencies engaged in the field of elementary education. With the present rates of teaching grants, private agencies ~~maintaining~~ elementary ~~schools~~ have expressed their inability to open additional elementary schools. Any general revision of the rates of teaching grants will entail heavy expenditure and will swallow the limited funds now ~~not~~ available for the expansion of elementary education. That is the reason why, in the current official year, subsidies were granted to local bodies levying the education tax for the opening of 839 schools. ~~and~~ Provision has been made in the next year's budget for the opening of 1017 ~~additional~~ schools in the areas of such local bodies. The question, however, of encouraging private agencies to open aided elementary schools in the areas of taluk boards not levying the education tax is under consideration and the D.P.I. has been asked to submit the necessary proposals in the matter, together with his recommendations as to an increase in the rates of teaching grants ~~for~~ <sup>to be allowed to</sup> such schools.
