Law(Education)Department

Mr. Porrett, the Adviser to Government on manual training, was recruited from England in 1914. His services were engaged in the first instance for a period of five years. On the completion of that period the Govt. sanctioned his permanent retention on a pay of Rs. 500-50-800. As regards his qualifications he holds a first class woodwork certificate of the City and Guilds of London and also certificates for Freehand and Model Drawing, Practical, Plane and solid Geometry and Building construction. He has also experience of training teachers in manual training in England.

He is in charge of the classes in the

Teachers' College, Saidapet, for the training of manual training instructors. He is also the expert adviser to the Director and the Govt. in regard to manual training. In this capacity he tours round the presidency, visits centres where manual training is proposed to be introduced and advises the managers of schools and local bodies as to the subjects which may be introduced in the several schools. If his services are dispensed with, the department will be left without expert assistance and the classes in the Teachers' College will also have to be ^{closed} ~~maintained~~. The proposal of the M.L.Cs is not therefore acceptable.

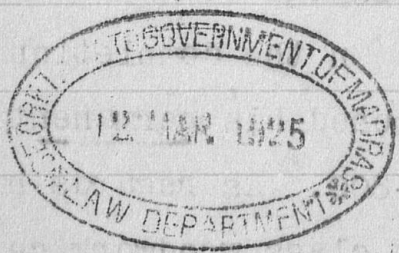
