RULES RELATING TO GRANTS-IN-AID OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION.

1. Grants or subsidies in aid of vocational education will ordinarily be limited to one-half of the non-recurring and recurring charges involved.
2. In the case of local bodies, if the financial position is not satisfactory, a subsidy in excess of one-half of the non-recurring cost and, where necessary, a subsidy equal to the entire non-recurring cost, may be given.
3. In the case of private managements, a grant in excess of half for the purpose of buildings and apparatus may be given if the managements establish the fact that they are unable to meet the cost.
4. As regards recurring cost, in very exceptional cases such as schools for the depressed classes or in backward areas, or where the local body or the management concerned is unable to contribute anything towards the cost of the scheme owing to its impecunious condition, a subsidy or grant in excess of one-half of the cost may be given for a single year.
5. As the terms of the assistance to be given to each institution are settled, they should be brought on to a register which will form the basis of the sanctioned recurring expenditure in the budget.

The sum of Rs.1,400 referred to above is for grants towards recurring charges on account of the introduction of manual training in the school departments of certain colleges and the sum of Rs.3800 is for similar grants for aided elementary schools. The M.L.C wishes to raise the question of policy and more money. The policy of Govt. is to encourage the introduction of some form of practical training in schools imparting general education. The Govt. sanction a suitable grant in each case, the grant representing ordinarily one-half of the charges involved by the scheme. In the case of managements and local bodies which are impecunious, a grant in excess of one-half of the cost is sanctioned for the first year.

2. A sum of about Rs.55,000 has been provided in the next year's budget for the continuance of manual training schemes, already sanctioned.

This is the total of the provision made under the various heads in the Budget.

Another sum of Rs.1.15 lakhs has been provided ~~in the~~
~~next year's budget~~ for new schemes. This amount
 will suffice for all the ~~schemes~~ that are now
 lying over for want of funds.
