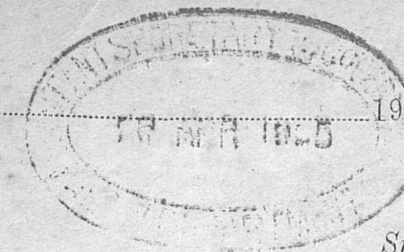

2. The sum of Rs.4,788/- taken credit for as Govern-
ment grant under the proviso to Section 37 in the Revised
Estimate for 1924-25 should be reduced by Rs.390, the unspent
balance deducted in G.O.No.165 Law (Education) dated 5-2-25.

3. With reference to sub-para (2) of G.O.No.1447 Mis.,
Law (Education) dated 11-9-24 credit should be taken in the
actuals of 1923-24 for a sum of Rs.694 as "appropriation
from Government grant unspent balance". Credit should be
taken under the same item in the Revised Estimate for 1924-25
for a sum of Rs.390/-.

4. The credit taken for a sum of Rs.10,000 in the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 as "Government grants under Capital" should be deleted since there is no provision in the Civil Budget Estimate for 1925-26 to sanction the amount.

5. The suggestions contained in paras 2 and 3 of the District Educational Council's remarks may be commended to the consideration of the Council.

6. The request for an additional amount towards the maintenance of Government Girls' School transferred to the management of the Municipality is not supported in view of the fact that Government have agreed to pay only a subsidy approximately equal to the annual recurring cost of the maintenance of the school incurred from Provincial funds at the time of transfer. Any extra expenditure will have to be met from the Council's own funds. Further there is no deficit in 1924-25 and 1925-26.

7. On the debit side of the budget under 'Capital' a sum of Rs.7,733 is shown in the actuals of 1923-24, while the corresponding entry on the credit side under the same item is only Rs.2,612. It is not indicated how the excess expenditure has been met.

8. The charges under 'Ordinary' in the actuals of 1923-24 exceed the 'ordinary' receipts. The Council has not indicated how the deficit was met.

The Municipal Council, Srirangam, contributes only Rs.4,710/- from their general revenues of Rs. 4 — i.e. per cent.

2. The Municipal Council may be requested to take early steps to introduce compulsory Education, to open higher standards in the already existing schools and to open new schools in the Municipal area where there is need in consultation with the Educational Officers.

3. The Municipal Council may also be requested to make adequate provisions for the improvement of 'Furniture and apparatus'.

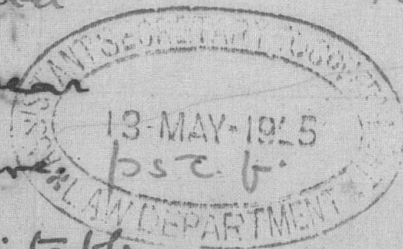

The budget estimate for the
 year 1925-26 of the elementary
 education fund under the control
 of the Municipal Council, Srirangam,
 is approved subject to the following
 remarks:--

(1) The credit taken for Provin-
 cial contribution under the proviso
 to section 37 of the Madras Element-
 ary Education Act, 1920, in the
 revised estimate for 1924-25 should
 be reduced to Rs.4,398. Credit
 should be taken in the actuals for
 1923-24 and in the revised estimate
 for 1924-25 for Rs.694 and for Rs.390
 respectively as 'appropriation from
 Government grant unspent blance'.

(2) The credit taken for a
 Government contribution of Rs. 10,000

11
in the budget estimate for 1925-26 under 'capital' should be deleted.

(3) In the actuals for 1923-24 a sum of Rs.7,733 is shown on the debit side under "Capital" while the amount exhibited on the credit side is only Rs.2,612. It should be explained how the excess expenditure was met.

(5) It is presumed that the opening ~~XXXX~~ balance of Rs.694/- which the Council had at the beginning of 1923-24 was completely utilised in that year.

(6) The attention of the Council is invited to the remarks contained in paragraphs 2 and 3 of the endorsement of the D.E.C. and ~~para 6~~ of the endorsement of the D.P.I. R.O.P. No. 17-B-3/24-25 dated 23-4-1925.

(4) In view of the financial condition of the council, its contribution to the elementary education fund for 1925-26 will, ~~XXXXXX~~ as a special case, be reduced to Rs.3,589. The consequential deficit in the budget should be avoided by reducing expenditure.
