Note on the elementary education fund.

Revised Budget for 1924-25 and
Budget estimate for 1925-26.

The opening balance for the revised budget is arrived at
as follows:--

In 1922-23 the receipt and charges-actuals-were each
Rs.3396-1-6. While approving the budget estimate for the year
1923-24 Government (G.O.No.1246, Law (Education) dated 6th Sept.1923)
remarked that "credit should be taken in the revised budget
estimate for 1922-23 for a sum of Rs.625/- as appropriation from
unspent balance of Government grant paid in previous years."
This means a balance of Rs.625/- should be carried over as the
opening balance for the year 1923-24. In the budget municipal
contribution for the year 1923-24 was stated to be Rs.2530/-
and towards this account a sum of Rs.1341-14-2 only was actually
paid leaving in arrears Rs.1188-1-10, which amount has been paid
to the elementary education fund during the current year (1924-25).
If this amount was paid in 1923-24, the closing balance would have
stood at Rs.1957/- and this has been taken as the opening balance
for the revised budget for the year 1924-25.

Receipts.

A Credit for Government grant has as usual been taken for
Rs.3368/- as advised in G.O.No.498 Mis., Law (Education) dated
4th April 1924 and the Municipal contribution has been fixed at Rs. 2400 which has actually been paid to the
credit of the fund. Since the full amount of municipal contribution
has been paid, further contribution on account of capital expenditure
is not proposed to be paid but will be appropriated ~~to be paid~~ from
the "Ordinary" head of the fund.

Expenditure.

Salaries and allowances for masters. provision has
been made only for the actual requirements.

A sum of Rs.200/- has been provided for as per Council's
Resolution No.1 A dated 13th August 1924 on account of the free
supply of books and slates to poor pupils in all the schools in the
Municipality. The year closes with a balance of Rs.2665/-

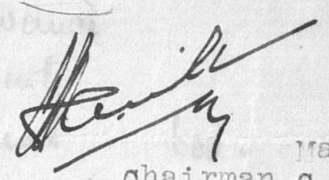
Receipts.

Credit has been taken for the usual government grant of Rs.3668. The Municipality took over the management of the Higher Elementary school subject to the condition that government bear the maintenance expenses. As the Municipality has been paying a larger amount of contribution in previous years, the Municipal share has been reduced a little. The total contribution from municipal funds to ordinary and capital is Rs.1750/-.

Expenditure.

(Ordinary.) The usual provision of Rs.200/- has been made for the free supply of books and slates.

(Capital.) The expenditure under furniture and apparatus will be met by a contribution from the municipal funds. The year will close with a balance of Rs.2663.

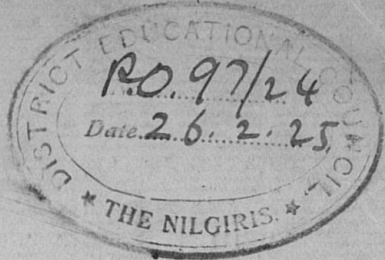
