S i r,

I am directed to inform you that the Legislative Council has voted a sum of Rs. 67,300 for grants to the Madras University in the year 1925-26 under section 44 (2) (b) of the Madras University Act, 1923. The details of the provision are as follow:--

(i) Vice-Chancellor's salary	30,000
(ii) Professorship of Economics	23,500
(iii) Recurring grant to the University Library	10,000
(iv) Grant payable to the University under G.O. No. 593 Finance, dated 15-8-1924 towards the normal cost of printing its notices in the Fort St. George Gazette.	3,750

As laid down in paragraph 4 of G.O.No. 620 Law(Education), dated 16-4-1924, the grants for items (i), (ii) and (iii) mentioned above will be disbursed in quarterly instalments and the contribution on account of the first item will be limited to Rs. 25,323, the amount actually needed for the purpose. Orders will be issued separately sanctioning the quarterly instalments of the grant towards the Vice-Chancellor's salary. Grants for the other objects will be placed at the disposal of the Univer-

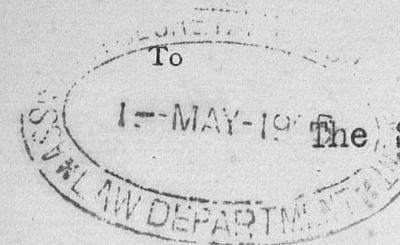

Extracts from the notes in the file relating to grants to the University in 1925-26
A sum of Rs. 67,300 has been voted by the

Legislative Council for grants to the University under section 44 (2) (b) of the Act. The details for the provisions are as follow:--

(i) Vice Chancellor's salary	Rs. 30,000
(ii) Professorship of Economics	23,500
(iii) Recurring grant to the University Library.	10,000
(iv) Grant to University payable under G.O.No.593 Finance 15-8-1924 for withdrawal of the concession of printing its notices in the Govt. Press	3,750

Under paragraph 4 of G.O.No. 620 Law (Education) dated 16-4-1924, the amount voted by the Council should be intimated to the University with a statement of the objects on which it should be utilised. The grant towards recurring expenditure will be disbursed in quarterly instalments in the beginning of each quarter in advance on application. The provision of Rs. 67,300 is for recurring expenditure. The grants under items (i) to (iii) should be disbursed in quarterly instalments. It does not seem necessary to disburse the grant under item (iv) in quarterly instalments, as it does not come strictly within the purview of section 44 (2) (b) of the Act and paragraph 4 of G.O. No 620 Law (Education), dated 16-4-1924 does not therefore apply to it. The whole grant may therefore be paid to the University on application.

2. In the linked file the application from the University for a grant of Rs. 25,323 towards the pay of the Vice-Chancellor for the year 1925-26 is dealt with. Last year the Finance Department agreed to the amount of the full year's salary being placed at the disposal

being placed at the disposal of the University, as that was the only grant in question. In the current year the prescribed procedure of paying the amount due to the University in quarterly instalments will presumably have to be followed in respect of the grant towards the Vice-Chancellor's salary as well as in the case of grants for other ~~university~~ objects. The amount due to the University for the Vice-Chancellor's salary for the first quarter in the current year is Rs.7,323. This amount may be placed at the disposal of the University. A draft order is submitted in the linked file. In regard to grants for other objects., the University may be asked to send an application. A draft letter to the Vice-Chancellor is submitted. The file may be sent to Finance U.O. with reference to 'M' on page 16 ante

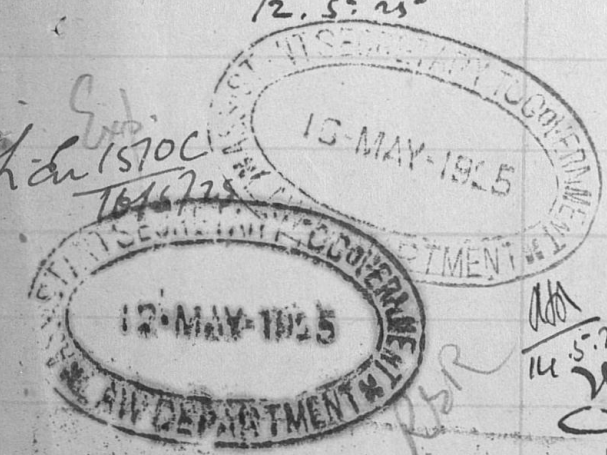
