Report of the Committee on Indian students, 1921-22: method by which the proposed University students' Information bureaux should obtain information regarding educational facilities abroad.

Sir,

In continuation of this Department letter No. 298, dated the 9th February 1925, I am directed to say that the Secretary of State has since intimated that it would be preferable for the University students' Information bureaux which are to replace the Provincial Advisory Committees to obtain information regarding the educational facilities available to Indian students in foreign countries by application to some body or bodies primarily concerned with educational matters instead of by direct correspondence with British Consuls-General abroad. In this connection I am to invite attention to the possibility of using the services of the International University Information Offices established by the League of Nations at Geneva. The Directing Board of that office are anxious to establish contact with individual universities, and in its bulletins will be found much information regarding educational facilities in foreign countries that may be of assistance to the bureaux in answering enquiries. Moreover, provision was made at the 1924 Assembly of the League of Nations (vide para. 26 of the Report of the Delegates from India) for the establishment in Paris of an Institute of Intellectual

Intellectual Co-operation, which, when set up, should be the most authoritative centre for supplying information of the kind the bureaux will require.

2. The Government of India suggest that the attention of the Universities might be drawn to the bulletins published by the International University Information Office or to the Institute of Intellectual Co-operation when established, to which they might apply for any further information they may require as to the educational facilities available to Indian students elsewhere than in the United Kingdom.

3. The authorised agents in India for the publications of the League of Nations are the Oxford University Press, Madras, Bombay and Calcutta.
