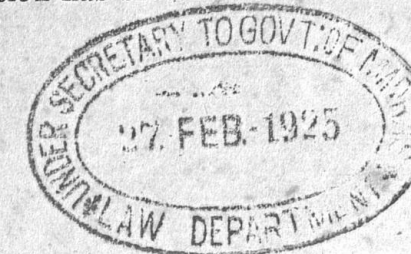

THE LAW (EDUCATION) DEPARTMENT.

732. Will the hon. the Minister for Education be pleased to state:

(a) whether there was a hostel for the Government Secondary Training School, Tiruvalur and the same was closed after the present headmaster came and whether the hotel-keeper was paid from the public fund when there was no hostel actually working;

(b) the reasons why the headmaster, Government Training School, Tanjore refused to run the hostel;

(c) whether the students especially the non-Brahmans sent a memorial for the opening of the hostel;

(d) the result of the memorial;

(e) whether the vessels and furniture of the hostel are allowed to deteriorate in the school lumber room to be used by the District Educational Officer, Tanjore and by the headmaster;

(f) whether the present headmaster is afraid to cope with the responsibility of conducting the hostel; and

(g) whether some of the students who signed the memorial are particularly teased and ill-treated in the school?

Clause (a) of Question No. 732 contains more than one question. The facts are as follows. There was a hostel attached to the secondary training school, Tiruvalur, which worked till 31-3-24. On this date the senior students were discharged and ¹⁵ dozen junior students who remained could not continue the hostel as the cost was too high. Consequently the headmaster made arrangements with a private hotel keeper to supply the students with meals in the hostel premises at the rate of Rs. 12 per mensem per head for two meals and one tiffin. No payment was made to the hotel keeper from provincial funds. The headmaster joined the school on 1-3-1924.

As regards (b) even prior to the amalgamation of the secondary training class, Tiruvalur, with the Tanjore school there was no hostel in the latter place. It is reported that there are ample facilities for board in Tanjore and that the cost of renting a building to be used as a hostel, even if one could be obtained, would be ~~expensive~~ exceedingly high.

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With reference to clauses (c) and (d) an anonymous petition was received with a few bogus initials. Enquiry elicited the fact that no students, non-Brahmin or other, would own to having sent the representation.

As regards (e) the vessels are kept safe within the school premises under lock and key. The question of transferring ^{them} to some other institution which may be in need of them is under consideration.

The following answer is suggested:-

"(a) Yes. The hostel keeper was not paid from public funds.

(b) Even prior to the amalgamation of the Tiruvalur and Tanjore schools there was no hostel. There is no urgent need for one and buildings are expensive and difficult to secure.

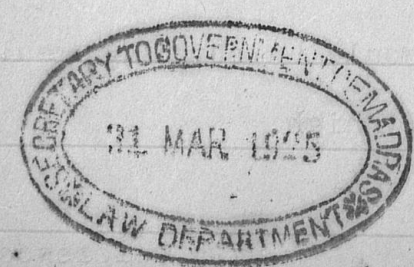
