Sir,

I have the honour to submit below a scheme for the introduction of weaving in the High school, Srirangam.

2. Instruction is proposed to be given to about 400 pupils of forms III to VI in batches of about 20 at a time, each batch receiving one period of instruction a week.

3. Mr. Porrett who examined the scheme estimates the recurring and non-recurring charges (including the cost of putting up a temporary shed 50' x 20') at Rs.630 and Rs.2360 respectively as detailed in the margin.

4. The plan and the estimate have been scrutinized and approved by the Special Consulting Architect.

5. The Correspondent requests that a full grant towards the non-recurring and a half grant towards the recurring charges may be sanctioned by Government.

6. I consider that no special treatment is necessary and would recommend the scheme, if the management is prepared to bear half the total cost.

7. No provision exists in the Budget estimate for 1924-25 for new schemes nor can I suggest at present any source from which the expenditure in question may be met.

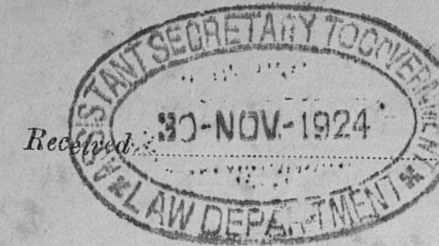
