Sir,

I have the honour to submit below a scheme for the introduction of book binding in the C.M.S. High School, Megnampurem in the Tinnevely District.

2. Instruction is proposed to be given to about 164 pupils of Forms I to V in batches of 20 pupils at a time, each batch receiving 2 consecutive periods of instruction per week.

3. Mr. Ponnett who examined the scheme estimates the recurring and non-recurring charges at Rs.295 and Rs.245 respectively as detailed in the margin.

4. The management is prepared to bear one half the cost of the scheme and the other half will have to be borne by Government.

5. I may state in this connection that the scheme does not appear to be very suitable for the place that there is no provision in the Budget Estimate for 24-25 for new schemes and that I am also unable at the present moment to suggest any savings from which the expenditure in question may be met.

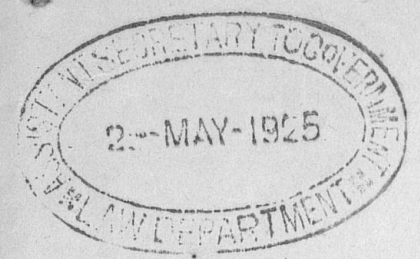

There is nothing in my office files to show
why Mr. Littlehailes stated that the scheme did
not appear to be very suitable for the place. I
can only suppose that he thought that in an out
of the way rural place like Megnanapuram book-
binding was hardly a suitable form of training
for the pupils of the high school. In this case
however it is impossible to relate the practical
instruction to the chief occupation of the loca-
lity, viz., toddy drawing. The school is entire-
ly surrounded by sand and palmyrah trees. I
think the scheme may be approved.

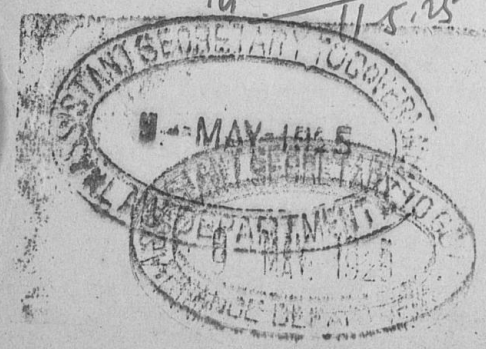

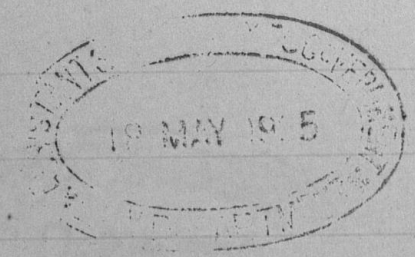
