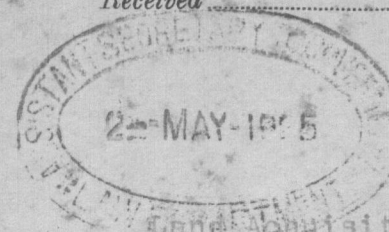

Sir,

The Managing Trustee of the Masilamony Mudaliar's Free Boarding and Lodging House, Vellore, requests that the vacant site T.S.318/2 lying to the North of the present Boarding House may be acquired under the Land Acquisition Act and that a half-grant on the total cost of acquisition may also be sanctioned.

The proposed site - vide plan enclosed - is to be used as a playground and garden. It is also intended to provide for future extensions to the boarding-house as the vacant space available in the Compound of the present boarding house will not suffice for the purpose.

The Collector has valued the site at Rs.1,500/- —
vide valuation statement enclosed - and the managing trustee
considers that purchase by private negotiations will not
afford valid title to the land as the owner of the land is a
minor. The boarding-house has a Committee of Management
registered under the Indian Companies Act of 1913.

In these circumstances, I have the honour to
recommend that the site T.S.318/2 may be acquired under the
Act and that the scheme may be placed in the list of approved
works at a cost of Rs.1,500/-..

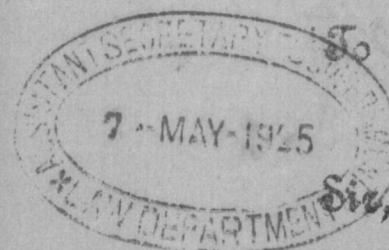

Land acquisition--Vellore taluk--South Vellore town-- S.No. 318/2--Extension of Masilamani Mudaliar's Thuluva Vellala Boys Free and Boarding and Lodging house --draft notification under section 4 (1) of the Land Acquisition Act-- submitted for publication.

I submit herewith a draft notification under section 4 (1) of Land Acquisition Act I of 1894 as amended by Land Acquisition Amendment Act XXXVIII of 1923 for approval and publication in the Fort Saint George Gazette.

2. The land is proposed to be acquired on behalf of the management of the Masilamani Mudaliar's Thuluva Vellala Boys Free Boarding and Lodging and Education Fund, Vellore which was registered under the Indian Companies Act (1913) last year. The land belongs to a minor by name Bakthavatsala Mudali and his father and guardian V. Gajaraja Mudaliar is willing to part with it for a reasonable price. But as a guardian cannot sell the property of his ward except in case of legal necessity, it is proposed to acquire the land under the Land Acquisition Act to secure an indefeasible title to it. The total cost of acquisition including the cost of trees, a brick wall and one-third portion of a well and 15% solatium comes to Rs 1479/-. The management has applied to the Director of Public Instruction for a half grant and the matter is pending with him. In the

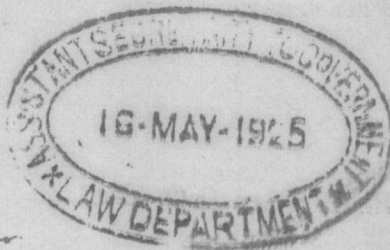

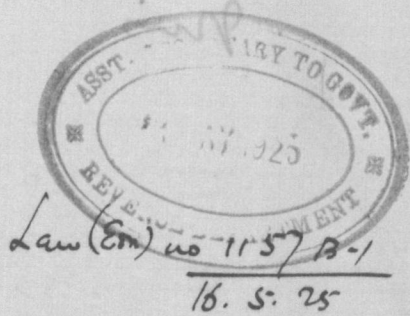
