The intention is to run it as a Government concern under the direct control of the D.E.O. Madras. At least 24 aided schools are expected to take advantage of the institute and I have no confidence in the joint management of 24 schools. Mr. Littlehailes was satisfied that these aided schools could not contribute to the cost and in any case a central institute, were Government to pay the whole cost, is much more economical than payment of a half grant to a large number of schools.
