Sir,

The Superintendent, Government Junior Certified School, Ranipet, has brought to my notice that a severe and sudden cyclone broke out at Ranipet at about 4 p.m. on 15-5-1925. The clothes of the boys had as usual been laid out to dry and air at the time and the boys had therefore to rush out to remove them into the dormitories. The storm, however, suddenly increased in intensity and some of the boys were forced to take shelter in the dining shed of the school which was close by. As soon as the boys had entered the shed the whole structure fell with a crash

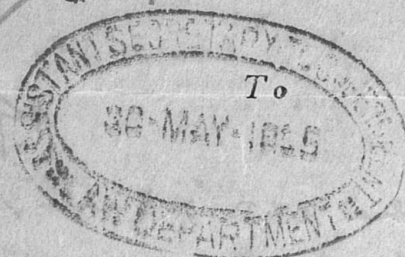
