She is therefore not ordinarily entitled to any advance for the purchase of a motor car under Article 156 of Civil Account Code, Volume I which is intended to apply to officers holding substantive appointments.

2. There is however no audit objection to Government in the Finance Department sanctioning to her under note 3 to Article 154 of Civil Account Code, Volume I the grant of an advance of Rs.1600/- bearing interest at 5% subject to the conditions laid down in Article 156 of Civil Account Code, Volume I and subject to the recovery of the amount before the expiry of her covenant.
