I have the honour to submit herewith a revised mark distribution lists for the Engineer, Upper, and Lower and probationary subordinate classes and to request that the Government will be pleased to substitute them for the present mark distribution lists contained in the rules relating to the constitution and working of the College of Engineering, Guindy, approved in G.O.No. 1604 Law(Education) dated 12- 11- 23.

(E)

At present some subjects which are taught and on which examinations are held have no marks allotted to them and the marks obtained on such subjects have to be incorporated with those allotted for some other

subjects

subjects. This method is reported to be unsatisfactory by the Principal of the College of Engineering, Guindy who also states that unless students know definitely that marks are awarded for a certain subject they are apt to take insufficient interest in that subject. Another reason for redistributing the marks is the fact that the equipment in the new laboratories is nearing completion and it is now possible to assign separate marks for the work done in each of the Laboratories. It will be observed that the total marks allotted to the different courses still remain the same. Further the new distribution will apply only to students entering the college in July next.

I request that the Government will be pleased to pass very early orders on this letter so that the changes proposed may be incorporated in the calendar for 1925-26 of the College of Engineering, Guindy, which should be printed during the summer vacation.
