Dated 27-11-1924.

Read the following:-

Consideration of the Budget Estimates of Elementary Education fund for 1925-'26 of the Local Bodies in the Nilgiri District.

(1) The District Educational Council calls upon the District Board to produce definite Government sanction to the reduction of its contribution from Rs.11,000/- for 1922-'23 to Rs.9750/- for the current year and passes a resolution that this contribution should in no circumstances fall below Rs.11,000/-.

(2) The District Educational Council insists upon the full utilisation of the provision of Rs.5200/- for expansion of education on that object and no other.

(3) The District Educational Council enquires of the District Board why part of this last provision should not be utilised for the free supply of books etc., to the depressed classes.

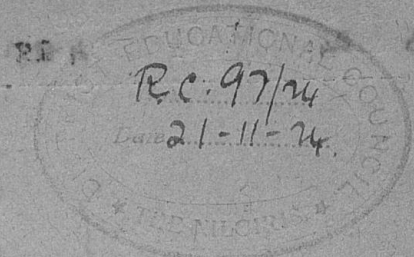

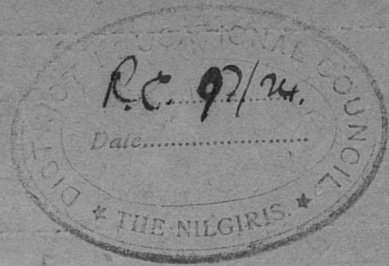

For 1925-26 the Board proposes to contribute a sum of Rs 11,600/- (9,800 + 1,800 under capital). In

the Normal budget the contribution has been fixed at Rs 12,300 (11,000 + 1,300 under capital). The Board may be asked to raised its contribution to this amount.

In the general budget provision for a contribution of Rs 9,800/- (Rs 8000 ordinary and Rs 1800 Capital) has been made to Ely. education for 1925-26 against Rs 11,600 (Rs 9800 ordy + Rs 1800 cap) in the Ely. education budget. Law (Edu) want the board to raise its contribution to Rs 12,300 the amount fixed in the Normal Budget. The main budget closes with a balance of Rs 8,083 under the general account and if the proposal of Law (Edu) is adopted the closing balance will be reduced to Rs 5,583 against the prescribed minimum of Rs 5044.

(i) The credit taken for the proceeds of the education cess in the actuals of 1923-24 and for the equivalent Government contribution under Section 34 of the Madras Elementary Education Act, 1920, in the R. F. for 1924-25 should be both raised to Rs 3,178/- with reference to G.O. no. 309 Law (Education) dated 3-3-1925. The credit taken for

provincial contribution in the B.F. for 1925-26 will be liable to subsequent adjustment with reference to the education cess actually realized in 1924-25.

(ii) The credit taken for provincial contribution in the B.F. for 1925-26 under the proviso to Section 37 of the Elementary Education Act will be liable to ~~subsequent~~ ^{subsequent} adjustment with reference to savings, if any, out of the subsidy paid in G.O. no. 1598 Law Edu. dated 16-10-1924.

(iii) With reference to the ~~order~~ ^{budget} in G.O. no. 2488 L & H dated 9-9-1924, the Board's contribution from its general revenues to the elementary education fund under its control should be raised to Rs 12,300/- including the contribution under 'Capital'.
