Attention is solicited to paragraph 1 of G.O. No. 226 Law (Edn) dated 27-2-22 wherein it was distinctly stated that the payment of the Government contribution towards the grant of the allowance of Rs 4 a month to teachers in the employ of local bodies was subject to the condition that the requisite funds therefor would be voted by the Legislative Council. This will be the position whether the allowance is paid as such or whether it merged in the salary. Please see G.O. No. 1475 Law (Edn) dated 17-10-23. The following draft answer is submitted for approval:-

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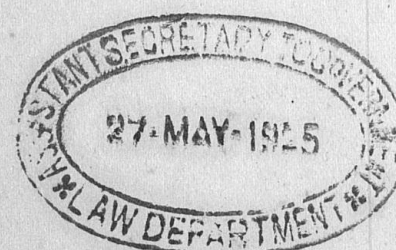
