Sir,

I have the honour to report that Mrs. A. Devasahayam, Assistant, Government Girls Secondary School, Salem, has written a set of eight geographical readers in Tamil for use in Elementary schools and sold the copyright in the books to the Christian Literature Society, Madras, for Rs.2500/. She has accepted from the publishers one half of the amount the other half being payable to her on or before the 31st October 1925. The teachers action in having accepted the amount of Rs.1250 (half of Rs.2500/-) is irregular as permission to accept remuneration exceeding Rs.1500 from a source other than general Revenues has to be accorded by Government (vide para 9

The Inspectress of Girls Schools, Western circle, reported that the books were written by the teacher during the holidays of 1923. It has also been ascertained that the teacher will have no financial interest in the sale of the books when published.
