With reference to the Government Order quoted above appointing members of the Board for the award of Secondary School Leaving Certificates, I have the honour to point out that under the Government notification "III. By Whom Awarded" the certificate shall be awarded by a Board consisting of the Director of Public Instruction as President, 5 officers of the Government Educational Department and 5 non-official members. Under the Government Order the Board will consist of 4 officials and 6 non-officials. I may further point out that M. R. Ry. Rao Bahadur M. C. Raja Avargal is only a

secondary trained teacher and is therefore not educationally qualified to deal with high school question papers, syllabuses and various other questions that come before the Board for consideration, nor will he be qualified to act as an examiner. In these circumstances it is respectfully requested that Government will be so good as to reconsider the question of appointing M.R.Ry.Rao Bahadur M.C.Raja Avargal a member of the Board.

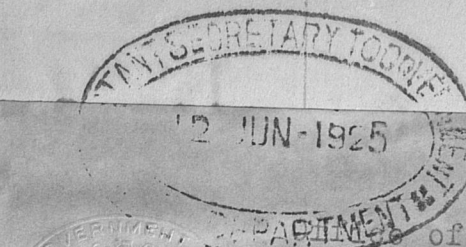

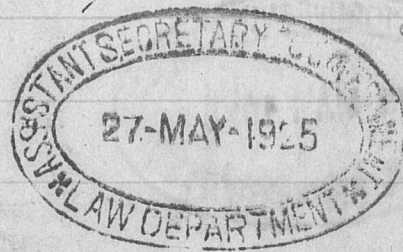
