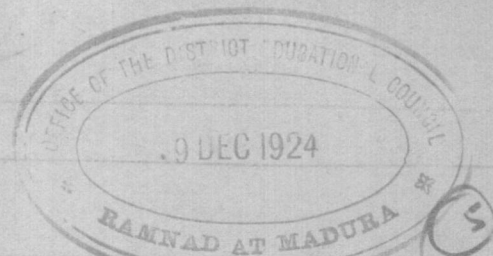

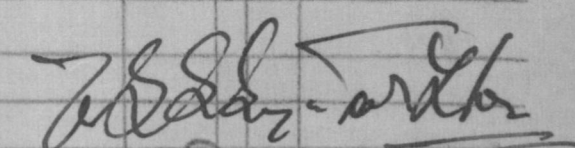

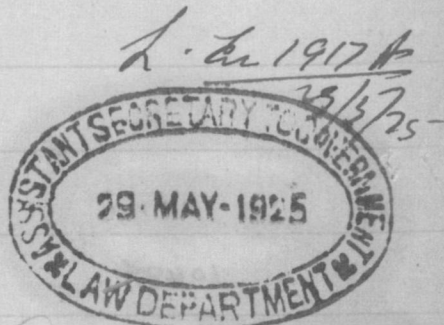

(1) The credit taken for Government contribution in the Revised estimate for 1924-25 and in the Budget estimate for 1925-26 under the provision of Section 37 of the Madras Elementary Education Act, 1920 shall be ~~both~~ reduced to Rs 26,686 & Rs 30,149 respectively.
