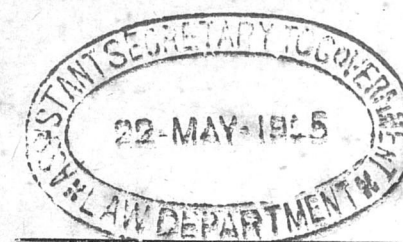

Sir.

I have the honour to report that the Taluk Board, Udayarpalayam, in its resolution No.186 dated 23-12-24 (copy enclosed) resolved to meet from the proceeds of the Education cess, a sum of Rs.1,250 for repairs and improvements to the Board School building at Udayarpalayam. When a copy of the resolution was received in this office, it was pointed out to the President, Taluk Board, in accordance with the orders contained in G.O.No.1151 Law (Education) dated 15-7-24, that the utilisation of the education cess and the equivalent Government contribution on any purpose other than the expansion

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expansion of elementary education is deprecated by Government. It was also indicated to the President that there are nearly 10 ~~xxx~~ school-less villages with a population of 1000 and above and 20 school-less villages with a population of 500 to 1000. It was further suggested that expenses on account of Capital items could be met from savings available in the elementary education fund, provided the same is shown in the Budget Estimate of the Elementary Education Fund under the Board's control. The President was requested to reconsider the resolution in the light of the above suggestions.

2. In answer to this office reference, the President reports that the opening of schools in the villages with a population of 1000 and above have already been sanctioned and some of them have already been opened and the opening of schools in villages with a population of 500 to 1000 is under consideration.

3. In the Budget Estimate for 1925-26 of the Elementary Education Fund, the Board has provided Rs.1000 under "repairs to buildings" to be spent on the Udayarpalayam School and the balance (Rs.250) is also to be met from the Education-cess. In addition to this amount, the Board intends to spend Rs.2,000/- (exclusive of the Udayarpalayam School) from the Education cess, in the current year. (Please see the President's letter R.C.No. 210/25 dated 7-5-25, (copy enclosed).

4. Doubtless the expenditure is required, but it should be met from some source, other than the Education cess.

Copy of letter R.C.No.210/25 dated 7-5-1925 from the President, Taluk Board, Udayarpalayam, to the Director of Public Instruction.

Ref: Your R.C.17-B/25 dated 23-4-1925.

I have the honour to state that it is proposed to spend Rs.1000/- from the current year's grant for repairs to schools, for repairing the Udayarpalayam School and to pay the balance of Rs.250/- also from the Educational cess.

In this connection I would request you to kindly accord permission to utilise Rs.2250/- more than the Education cess of the current year as a special case for repairs to school houses as more than half a dozen school buildings are in urgent need of repairs and as the estimates hereunder given are pending sanction for want of funds, the general revenue of the Board closing with a heavy deficit balance.

According to the figures recently furnished by

the D.P.I., there are 30 schoolless centres with a population of over 500 inhabitants in the area under the jurisdiction of the Taluk Board, Udayarpalayam.

It is proposed to provide 21 centres with schools ^{with the consent of the Government} by paying subsidy to the Board. Therefore, there will be only 9 centres which will be left unprovided. ~~The Taluk Board has reported to the D.P.I. that, the question of opening schools in these villages is engaging its attention.~~

It will be seen from the linked file that the Board proposes to open ten additional schools, and that, according to the Budget Estimate for 1925-26, there will be a closing balance ^{about} of Rs. 14,000/- ~~only~~. Repairs to school buildings are non-recurring charges and cannot be compared with ^{expenditure on} the revision of the salaries of teachers, (a recurring charge) which was deprecated in G.O. No. 1151 Law (Edn) dated 15.7.1924.
