Sir,

I have the honour to address Government on the subject of halting allowances to be paid to members of the District Educational Councils who have to stay at head-quarters for attending the meeting of this council immediately before or after a District Board meeting of which body also, they are members.

(2) In G.O.No.498 Law (Education) dated 21-4-1922 and Memo No.2388 A-I dated 26-6-1922, it is laid down that, as far as possible meetings of District Educational Councils should be held immediately before or after a District Board meeting, so that the T.A. of District Board members may not be debited to this council. This practice is adopted by me as far as possible. In their order 362 Law (Education)

dated 14-3-1925, Government regretted their inability to sanction halting allowances to members attending special committee meetings. But no ruling has hitherto been given ^{by Government} on the special point under reference. Some members of this council who are away from head-quarters and happen to be District Board members also, come for a District board meeting and have to halt for a day at head-quarters in order to attend a District Educational Council meeting immediately before or after it; such members should, in my opinion, be paid halting allowance in as much as their travelling allowance is not debited to this council.

I have therefore the honour to request that Government will be pleased to sanction to such members who attend meetings of District Educational Councils held immediately before or after the District Board meeting halting allowance at single second class rates subject to the budget allotment under travelling allowance sanctioned for the council.

Subject:- Halting allowance to members of D.E.C's staying at headquarters after meetings of Dist. Boards for the meeting of the D.E.C.

A.S.

(G) under G.O. 1647 Law Edu. dated 17-11-1921, halting allowances are not admissible to members of D.E.C's. The travelling allowance of members attending the meetings of both the D.E.C's and the Dist. Boards held at the same place was ordered to be debited to the funds of the Dist. Board. The President, D.E.C., Coimbatore, suggests that halting allowance may be given to those members of the D.E.C who are also members of the Dist. Board, and who have to halt at headquarters either before or after the meeting of the D.E.C. Such members are paid the travelling allowance admissible, and it is immaterial whether that charge is met from the funds of the local board or from the funds of the D.E.C. It is not desirable to make a difference between a member who has to make a halt after attending a meeting of the District Board, and a member who has to attend sub-committee meetings for two or three days in continuation.
