[C.No. 3149 B] - From the D.P.I., R.O.C. No.468 B/25 dated 12-11-25.

The D.P.I. enquires whether grants will be given to the Lawrence Memorial Royal Military School, Lovedale, under the Code of Regulations for European Schools as in the case of other recognised aided institutions under private management. This question was examined in the notes to G.O.No.184, Law (Edn), dated the 7th February 1924. As will be seen from those notes, the position of the Lawrence School is not exactly similar to that of other institutions under private management. The school receives a special recurring Imperial grant of Rs 2.30 lakhs and a recurring grant of Rs 32,000 from Provincial funds. These grants are outside the provisions of the Code of Regulations for European schools. When the Provincial grant was fixed at Rs 32,000 a year, it was expected that the school would be able to meet its entire expenditure from that grant and the Imperial grant referred to above and the income from the endowments, etc. belonging to the school. Apparently the annual expenditure has increased. In paragraph 6 of this Govt's letter to the Govt. of India dated the 27-8-23, it was stated that, if the school was ~~hased~~ placed under a Board of Trustees and treated as a private institution, the school would be eligible for a share of the grants distributed annually among schools under private management. Thus, the intention is that the school should be given grants admissible under the Code. In giving such grants the D.P.I. will of course have to take into account the Imperial

Submitted that an institution will become eligible
for a grant under the code of Regulations for European
Schools only when the expenditure exceeds its income.
If there is such excess, it is open to the Director
to make a grant to cover the whole or a portion of
the deficit according to the circumstances of the case.

In the case of the Lawn Memorial School, the question of
giving a grant under the code will arise only when the
expenditure on the institution exceeds its income from
fees, endowments etc, and the grants from Imperial and
Provincial funds, amounting to Rs. 2.30 lakhs and Rs. 32000,
respectively. The draft order authorises the Director
to make a grant under the code under the above circum-

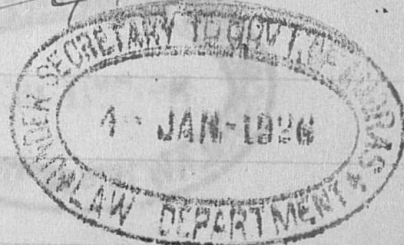

My dear Krishnamachari,

Will you please see your D.O.No. 3149 B-2 dated 10th December regarding Lawrence Memorial Royal Military School, Lovedale-Grants under the Code of Regulations for European Schools. I discussed this question yesterday afternoon with the Hon. Mr. Moir. I understand that he was of opinion that the school should receive only an annual lump grant which is at present fixed at Rs. 32,000/-. This is to be considered as a consolidated grant from Government in lieu of the different kinds of grants, teaching grants, boarding grants, cadet grants, fee remission grants, medical inspection grants, building grants and equipment grants which are or may be awarded under the Code of Regulations for European Schools.

I presume that Government will issue some orders on the subject but if not I shall be glad to know in order that I may inform Mr. Padfield, the Principal of the school, of the position.
