Read the following letter from H. SEWELL, Esq., Acting Collector of Trichinopoly, to H. E. STOKES, Esq., Acting Secretary to the Board of Revenue, dated 6th January 1876, No. 1 :—

The revised scheme of the District Post Establishment for this district approved of in Board's Proceedings, No. 3302, dated the 17th November 1874, was to take effect with the sanction of Government from 1875-76; accordingly provision was made in the Provincial Budget for 1875-76, and was sanctioned by Government, under date the 15th February 1875, Proceedings No. 324, Financial Department. But, in the absence of the special sanction of Government for the entertainment of the additional establishment which the revised scheme involves, the Accountant-General objects to pass the pay of the nineteen rural delivery peons employed from September last. I have the honor therefore to request that the sanction of Government may be obtained for the additional establishment included in the revised scheme.

Submitted to Government with the request that the revised scheme of Postal Establishment approved in Board's Proceedings, dated 17th November 1874, No. 3302, recorded in G.O., dated 9th December 1874, No. 2063, may be expressly sanctioned with retrospective effect from the date of its introduction. The requisite provision was made in the Budget for the current year.
