No. 136. Read the following Proceedings of the Board of Revenue, dated 3rd February 1876, No. 329:—

Read the following letter from W. S. FOSTER, Esq., President of the Local Fund Boards, Godavery District, to H. E. STOKES, Esq., Acting Secretary to the Board of Revenue, dated Cocanada, 11th November 1875, No. 98:—

I have the honor to inform you that I have issued orders, on the request of the Circle Board at their meeting of 19th October 1875, to open the dispensary at Nursapur, sanctioned in G.O., No. 189, dated 1st February 1875, for out-door patients only for the present, with the following establishment,

One ward cooly, on Rupees 5 a-month,  
,, waterman, on „ 4 do.

from the 1st of November 1875, in anticipation of the sanction of Government, as the Circle Board thought that the opening of the dispensary at that place is very necessary with reference to the present bad season. The Circle Board further sanctioned a rent of Rupees 6 a-month for a building until a new one is constructed. I request therefore that you will be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for the same.

Submitted for the sanction of Government.

2. At a meeting held on the 19th October 1875, the Ellore Circle Board resolved to use, as a Local Fund dispensary, the building now occupied by the Police hospital at Nursapur until the question of the erection of a permanent building is disposed of, and to utilize the services of the Medical Subordinate attached to the Police hospital by giving him some extra allowance to be hereafter fixed by the Local Fund Board.

3. There is a lump allotment of Rupees 2,000 in the current year's Budget from which the cost of the proposed establishment as well as that of the medicines required can be met.
