SIR,

With reference to the Resolutions of the Government of India, dated 7th August 1868, No. 2007, and 31st July 1875, No. 2430 (Accounts), I am directed to transmit a Statement showing the Receipts and Charges of the Madras University for 1874-75.

2. It will be seen that the aggregate receipts of the year amounted to Rupees 29,987-14-0 and the charges to Rupees 40,725-13-6, the difference Rupees 10,737-15-6 being met from Provincial Funds.

3. The difference being *bond fide* an assignment in aid of the University Fee Fund, I am to request that the concession made to the Calcutta University, that any assignment to its Fee Fund shall be treated as an Imperial charge, may be extended to the Madras University as well.

4. The estimated receipts and charges for 1876-77 of the Madras University are Rupees 35,260 and Rupees 52,568, respectively.
