No. 173. Read the following letter from R. W. LODWICK, Esq., Accountant-General, Madras, to the Hon. W. HUDLESTON, Chief Secretary to Government, Fort St. George, dated Fort St. George, 12th February 1876, No. 691 :—

Book Department.

With reference to G.O., No. 122, dated 20th January 1876, Financial Department, paragraph 3, I have the honor to forward copy of Memorandum received from the Supervisor, Government Press, No. 218, dated 11th February 1876, from which it will be observed that Rupees 1,723 were the receipts during 1874-75 for private advertisements inserted in the *Fort St. George Gazette*, and not for work executed by the Press Office for private persons.

2. With regard to paragraph 6, I have the honor to state that the monthly statements rendered from this office to the Board of Revenue include the heads of Provincial Services under their control, and that the sum of Rupees 5,766 was exhibited in the statement sent to them for November 1874 under Printing, with full explanation that it was an adjustment on account of payment made by the Secretary of State for India for supplies received by the late Superintendent, Government Press, for issue to Collectorate Presses, as per G.O., No. 49, dated 17th January 1874, Public Department.
