No. 194. Read the following Proceedings of the Government of India in the Financial Department, dated Fort William, the 12th February 1876, No. 855 (Accounts) :—

RESOLUTION.—With a view to prevent the inconvenience which at present arises from Financial Returns for the Government of India being prepared on paper of different sizes, the Governor-General in Council is pleased to rule that, except in cases of absolute necessity, only foolscap sized paper shall in future be used for any Returns or Estimates submitted to the Government of India in this Department.
