Resolution in this Department, No. 776, dated 28th May 1880, directing that, until further orders and so long as the amounts are unimportant, the proceeds of royalties on mines and quarries within Cantonment limits shall be credited to Cantonment Funds throughout British India.

RESOLUTION.—When materials are required by the State for any public purpose from quarries within Cantonment limits, no royalty should be levied, or charge of any kind made, by the Cantonment Committees on such materials.

Ordered that this Resolution be communicated for information to the Military, Revenue, and Public Works Departments.

Ordered, also, that the Resolution be communicated to the several Local Governments and Administrations, to the Comptroller-General, to the Accountants-General, and to the Comptrollers for information.
