No. 69. From F. C. DAUKES, Esq., Under Secretary to the Government of India, Home, Revenue, and Agricultural Department (Public), to the Local Governments and Administrations in the Bengal Presidency except Punjab, dated Fort William, 20th December 1880, No. 57—1922-28.

Her Majesty's Secretary of State has recently pointed out that, when his authority is required for the extension of the term of service of a Military Officer in Civil employment after attaining the age of fifty-five years, the necessary sanction should be obtained previous to that event. I am accordingly directed to request that this order may in future be carefully observed, and that sufficient notice may always be given to the Government of India in such cases to admit of a timely reference being made to the Secretary of State.
