Read the following papers :—

No. 6. From W. DONALD, Esq., Officiating Accountant-General, to the Chief Secretary to Government, dated Fort St. George, 25th December 1880, No. 4953.

Treasury Account Department.

With reference to the endorsement in the Financial Department, No. 2359, dated the 10th December 1880, communicated to me in G.O., Public Works Department, dated 14th December 1880, No. 745-R, from which it appears that no final orders have been passed by Government regarding the question of meeting charges for providing proper conservancy arrangements in the vicinity of Railway Stations, I have the honor respectfully to request that I may be instructed whether, under the circumstances, I am to continue to pass against Provincial Revenues the charge on account of the Conservancy Establishment at the Pothanur Railway Station, sanctioned in the Resolution of the Government of India, Financial Department, recorded in the Madras Government, dated the 5th February 1866, No. 441, Public Works Department, and if so, for what further period.

No. 7. From W. WILSON, Esq., Collector of Coimbatore, to the Chief Secretary to Government, dated Erode, 22nd January 1881, No. 2.

I have the honor, in reply to your Official Memorandum, No. 101, dated 17th current, to inform you that there is not now any necessity for continuing an arrangement made at a time when no other arrangement was possible: the cost of the conservancy of the Pothanur Paracheri is a proper debit to Local Funds, and the Local Fund Board will be requested to make such arrangements in this behalf as may be required. The matter will be laid before them at their meeting to be held on the 29th January 1881. Meanwhile I have to suggest that present arrangements be permitted to continue till the end of the current official year, and that the new order of things commence with a new year.

No. 8. ORDER THEREON, 4th February 1881, No. 207.

The Government consent to the charge in question being debited against Provincial Services for the remainder of the current official year. Thereafter it must be borne by Local Funds.

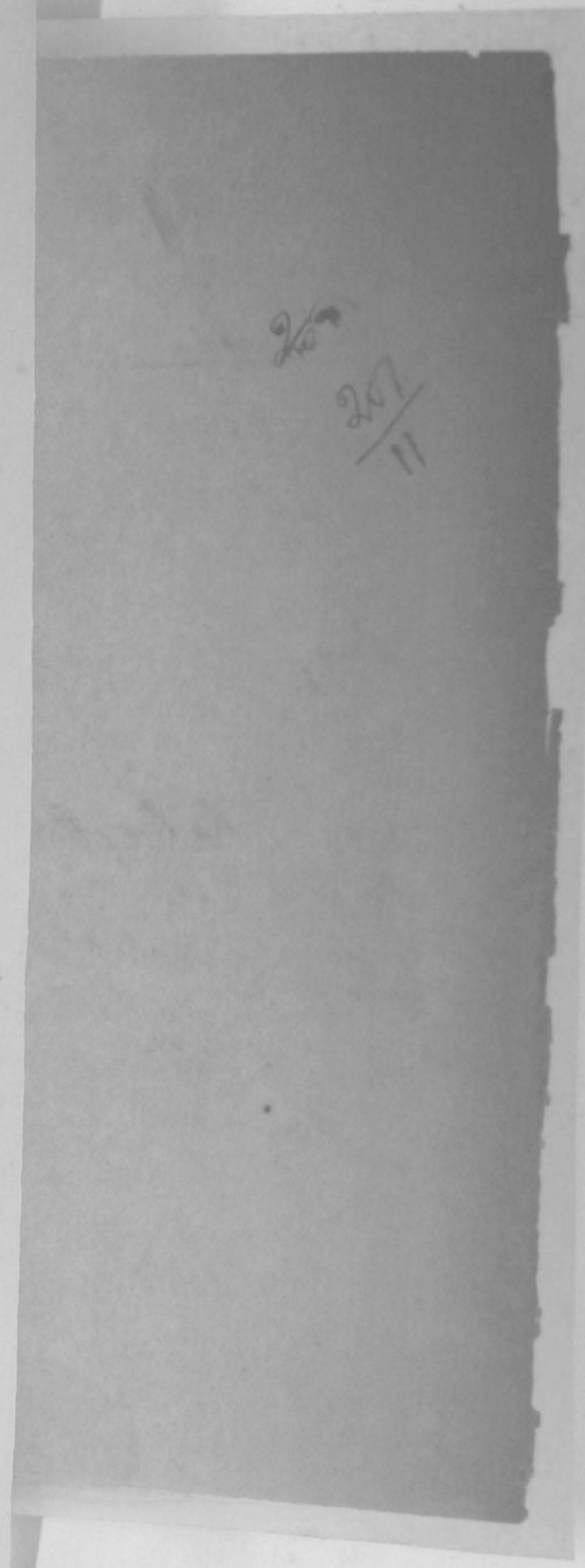
