Local Fund—Education.—The closing of the
Local Fund School at Rayachoti in the Madana-
palle Circle, Cuddapah District, sanctioned.

1878. It was sanctioned by Govern-
ment in G.O. No. 270 dated 14th February
1879. It was opened on the 11th December
1879, the reason of the delay being
explained in my letter No. 43 dated
24th January 1880. It started with 10
boys; which number, after fluc-
tuations which never exceeded 23,
has now dwindled to seven. It was
examined by the Inspector of schools
in January 1880; and the Director
of Public Instruction in reviewing
that report in his Proceedings No. 543
dated 16th February 1880 recorded his
opinion that materials for the school
hardly existed. Consequent upon
the monthly numerical returns
showing a falling off in numbers
and upon my own inspections,
I asked the Deputy Inspector of
schools for a special report. This

he forwarded on the 2nd instant
and I have the honor to enclose a
copy. $\frac{92(21-22)}{3}$
3. The only reason I can give
for this failure is that the town
of Rayachoti has three Prial schools;
one of which, kept by Nagisam, has
between 90 and 100 boys. The parents
and guardians of the children of a
schoolgoing age prefer these; one
chief reason being that these schools
open early in the morning and keep
the children out of mischief from
7 to 9 A.M. when they are not
wanted at home while the day's house
work is being done. These two
hours schooling are in addition
to the regular hours of Prial schools
which then conform to the Local
Fund school hours. I find also
that parents and guardians
think that the longer children
are in school, the more they
get

get for their payments for them.
The Head Master of the Local Fund
school is a Telugu Matriculate
and does not appear to be very
popular. I have not however found
that he is any way to blame
nor do I consider that, if he were
changed, the school could still
survive. I regret to add that the
non official members of the Local
Fund Board who live in Royachoti
have paid the school but
very little attention - one member
in fact having to appeal to the
Head Master to know if he had
ever been there at all. They stated
at the Local Fund Board's
meeting of the 6th instant that
they had talked to parents and
guardians but without success.

4. Personally I am not surprised
at

at the failure of the ⁽²¹⁻²²⁾ school. A similar
school in Royachoti failed once
before in similar circumstances.
At the same time I did not
consider it my province to Oppose
(beyond warning and giving my
opinion) the expressed wish of
the majority of the members of the
Local Fund Board that a second
trial should be made.

Submitted through the Board
of Revenue for the sanction of Govern-
ment. Royachoti is a town con-
taining 4,836 inhabitants, and
it is a matter for regret that
the school should not have
succeeded; but as the Board
will observe, this is the second
time the school has failed.
The attendance is now very low
and

and there appears to be no use
in keeping the schools open as
there is little likelihood of its
proving a success. The undersigned
therefore recommends that the sanction
of Government be sought for closing
it.
