Municipal—Lands.

Read the following paper :—

No. 17. *From J. KELSALL, Esq., Acting Collector of the Kistna District, to the Chief Secretary to Government, dated Masulipatam, 18th November 1880, No. 2560.*

In G.O. of July 18th, 1879, No. 1370, it was stated that “the Government consider that the duty of maintaining in proper order land in Municipal limits reserved for general public purposes (poramboke) devolves on Municipalities under the law enabling them to raise funds for Municipal purposes.”

2. The Municipal Commissioners of Masulipatam passed on this the resolution attached. Mr. Horsfall then directed the Tahsildar to prepare a statement of the extent of “land reserved for general purposes” within the Municipality.

3. That has been received and is enclosed. I now, as requested, have the honor to forward the resolution for the consideration of Government.

4. I cannot support it. The proposal does not seem at all practicable or advisable. The Commissioners do not say to whom they propose to rent the land or for what purpose.

10. G.O., No. 1370, dated 18th July 1879, Municipal lands. Opinion expressed that the duty of maintaining in proper order land in Municipal limits reserved for general purposes (poramboke) devolves on Municipalities under the law enabling them to raise funds for Municipal purposes.

The Commissioners consider that as there is such a large area of “poramboke” in this Municipality, the funds do not permit of their being kept in good order. They suggest that such lands may be handed over to the Municipality when a nominal rent could be fixed; and by this means enable the Commissioners to keep the lands in question free from prickly-pear and croton plants.

No. 18. ORDER THEREON, 7th February 1881, No. 233.

Poramboke land is land reserved for public purposes; that is to say, in the case of a Municipality, for such purposes as house-sites for extension of town, burial and burning grounds, cart-stands, latrines, &c. If, without interfering with such uses, it can be temporarily utilised for any other profitable purpose, the Government have no objection to Municipal funds benefiting by such use. But it must be strictly temporary, and power to resume at short notice must be reserved.

2. The Commissioners will, of course, note that the Municipality cannot make any unusual charge for the use of the poramboke land when applied to the public purposes mentioned above.
