PROCEEDINGS OF THE MADRAS GOVERNMENT.

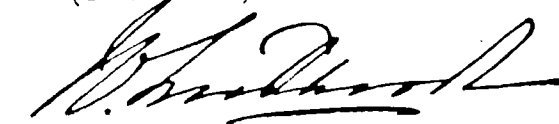
Dated 24th June 1862, No. 1,464.

1. As resolved in their Proceedings of 17th June 1862, No. 1,376, the Government authorize the Accountant General to place out of the Public Works Reserve of the current year funds to the extent noted in the margin* at the disposal of the undermentioned District Engineers for the construction and repair of Police Station Houses and Huts. This sum is exclusive of the amount, Rupees 8,519, provided for repairs to Police Buildings in the current year's Budget.
