READ—the following paper :—

From the Hon'ble S. SRINIVASA RAGHAVAIYANGAR, Dewan Bahadur, C.I.E., Inspector-General of Registration, to the Chief Secretary to Government, dated Coimbatore, 19th July 1895, T. No. 3598 (a).

I have the honour to submit, for the sanction of Government, a proposal to open a new registration office at Mullasserri, in the Ponnáni taluk, Malabar district.

2. The work in the Chavakkat and Tripriar sub-registry offices has increased enormously, the registrations in those offices having amounted to 6,097 and 5,169, respectively, during the last official year, and the sub-registrars, in consequence, find it impossible to attend carefully to the details of their office work and accept *all* the documents presented to them daily for registration. The parties resorting to the offices are put to great inconvenience in consequence of the delay in the registration of their documents, and it is believed that, owing to this cause, many documents which are optionally registrable are not at all brought for registration. To afford relief to the sub-registrars and to obviate inconvenience to the registering public, the District Registrar of Calicut proposes to constitute a new sub-district to be designated "the sub-district of Mullasserri" by detaching the four amshoms of Annakara, Brahmakulam, Mullasserri and Venkitangu from the sub-district of Chavakkat and the amshom of Vatanapalli from the sub-district of Tripriar. Mullasserri, where the new office is proposed to be located, is an important village situated at easy distances from the several amshoms proposed to be attached to it and near the high road leading to some of these amshoms.

3. The Collector of Malabar, who was consulted on the subject, has preferred the village of Chetwai to Mullasserri for the head-quarter station of the sub-district. Chetwai would, perhaps, be an eligible station for the above purpose if the three amshoms of Mullasserri, Venkitangu and Vatanapalli alone were detached to constitute the new sub-district, but as it is proposed to transfer two more amshoms from Chavakkat to give sufficient relief to the sub-registrar, it will be more convenient to have an office established at Mullasserri, which is more or less centrally situated with regard to the several amshoms referred to. Moreover, if the office were located at Chetwai, the inhabitants of all the amshoms except Vatanapalli would be put to much inconvenience, especially during the rainy season, as they would have to cross on their way to Chetwai a ferry which is reported to be unfordable during that season. From enquiries made during my recent tour in Malabar, I have learnt that the balance of public convenience is decidedly in favour of opening an office at Mullasserri.

4. The effect of the proposal on the work of the existing and proposed offices will be seen from the subjoined table :—

From the above it will be seen that there will be sufficient work for the new office to start with, and that the pressure of work in the other offices will be equalized.

5. In these circumstances, I have the honour to request that the Government may be pleased to sanction the opening of a sub-registry office at Mullasserri with effect from the 1st October 1895, and the following expenditure in connection therewith, for which provision has been made in the budget estimate:—

The above expenditure is exclusive of the 20 per cent. commission payable to the sub-registrar, amounting to Rs. 600 a year. There is no doubt that the additional expenditure involved will be more than recouped in the course of a few years by the development of registrations brought about by the increased facilities afforded to the public, as has happened in the case of the new offices opened from time to time in Malabar. The new office at Mullasserri will also be self-supporting from the commencement.

6. I beg to submit, for approval and publication in the Fort St. George and Malabar District Gazettes, a draft notification giving effect to the above proposal. The usual proposition statement in respect of the charges, and the list showing the distances of the amshoms from their present and proposed head-quarter stations, are also enclosed.
