RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR,

We have the honour to transmit the enclosed petition (with its enclosures) for remission of sentence from Vellayan Karayalan *alias* Nirai Kalathan Karayalan, a convict in Her Majesty's Penitentiary, Madras.

2. It will be seen that the petitioner was convicted by the Sessions Judge of Tinnevely under section 397 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to seven years' rigorous imprisonment. He appealed to the High Court but his appeal was dismissed. He then petitioned this Government but, after a careful enquiry into his case, His Excellency the Governor in Council saw no reason to interfere.

3. We have no recommendation to make in the petitioner's behalf.

4. The delay in the transmission of this petition has been due to the fact that a reference to the Government of India was made in the first instance, the reply to which was only recently received.
