No. — In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1, sub-section (3) of the Petroleum Act, 1886, and in extension of so much of Judicial Notification No. 193, published at page 469 of the Fort St. George Gazette, dated 26th May 1891, as applies to the ports of Badagara and Ponnani, the Governor in Council is pleased to direct that, from 1st May 1895, the provisions of the Act, other than those relating to dangerous petroleum and the importation of petroleum, shall extend to the following places in the Malabar district:—

Badagara in Kurumbranad taluk.	East, a line quarter mile eastwards of the coast road and parallel to it. South, Varikal Thodu. West, sea. North, a line through the 30th milestone at right angles to the road.
Ponnani in Ponnani taluk.	East, public way leading to Tirkarri and public way east of Tirkarri leading to Kundakadavu. South, Hajiya mosque. West, sea. North, river.
