ORDER—dated 4 May 1895, No. 915.

UNDER the provisions of Section 466, Criminal P. C., it is directed that criminal lunatic *Maddimulla Sahib* be sent to the Lunatic Asylum at Madras for safe custody and treatment; the usual periodical reports being made of the state of his mind.

2. The Superintendent of the *D. T.* Jail at *Bellary* will forward criminal lunatic *Maddimulla Sahib* at once to his destination and intimate the despatch to the Superintendent of the Asylum by letter accompanied by all necessary papers.
