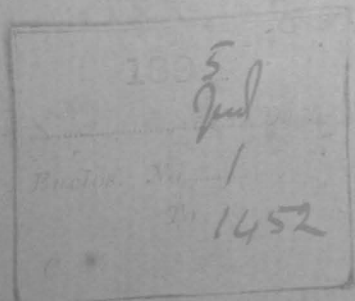
In the opinion of the Doctor his

last and to support the recommenda-
-tion of the Committee that
Pupil, No. 142, Zeinulabdin be
released from the school in
August next. The boy, a Mussalman
was admitted into the school
on 11 October 1890 for a detention
of

of six years and will, therefore,
in the ordinary course, be discharged
on the 10 October 1896, but the
Medical officer, on the day of
the meeting estimated his age
at 17 years and six months.
I, therefore, beg to recommend
that, under Article 11 of the
Reformatory Schools Act, sanction
be accorded for the release of
the boy on the 8 August next.

Prisoner in Calendar case N. 345 of 1890,
was convicted before me V. Balasundram
Rai, 2nd Class Magistrate of Vellore
Town, North District, of the offence of

380 I.P.C., Act 45 of 1860, and was sen-
tenced to undergo (4) four months
rigorous imprisonment; you
are hereby required to receive the
said Zeinulabdin into your custody
in the said jail of Vellore together with
this warrant, and there carry the afore-
said sentence into execution according
to law.
