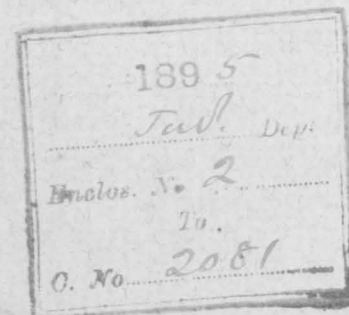

2. The trial lasted for 5 days and
ended in the acquittal of the
accused — not so far as I can see
from the Public Prosecutor's de-
fault.

3. On the 10th January, the Public
Prosecutor conducted the prosecu-
-tion in another case (viz. balendar
Case no. 3 of 1895) and I have sanc-
-tioned Rupees 20 separately for
that day's work.

4. I therefore beg to recommend
that a fee of Rupees 100 may be
sanctioned for this case at
Rupees 25 per diem for the
remaining

remaining four days during which
the Prosecutor was engaged with
it.
