Sir, The Second Class Magistrate of
Eruppattur, in this District, has applied
to me under Section 506 of the Criminal
Procedure Code, for the issue of a Commission
to take the evidence of 3 witnesses in Colombo.
This requisition is made by him, on the
application of the accused in C.C. No. 497
of 94, on his file, and the accused's vakil
has filed a list of interrogatories, to be
answered by the abovementioned 3 witnesses.

2 Section 503 of the Criminal Procedure
Code, does not seem to authorize the District
Magistrate, to issue a Commission, to a
Colony, where there is no British Indian
Representative, and I have the honor to
request the favor of instructions, as to how
I should act in the matter. The ends of
Justice will be sufficiently met, if the
witnesses are merely examined on Commission,
without compelling their attendance, and
at the same time, entailing on the accused,
the cost of defraying the expenses of the
witnesses.

gatories filed by the accused, and solicit
early orders on the Subject.
