Part I of the revised Lunatic Asylum Code received with the foregoing papers has not been so carefully prepared as it should have been. It appears to be, almost entirely, a mere reprint of Parts I to IV of the volume entitled "Law relating to Lunatics" published in 1883 and does not show the various amendments introduced by subsequent legislation and orders; while, on the other hand, it retains a number of obsolete rulings and regulations. The whole of Part I has therefore been recast and a copy of it, as revised, will be forwarded.

I suggest any further alterations he may consider necessary.
The following are the principal alterations which have been made in Part I:—

(a) The several *Ludia Aali* included in this Part have been amended up to date and printed chronologically.

(b) The *Dumak Soldiers' Property Act*, XIV of 1873, has been added.

(c) As the Code is intended only for the use of officers in charge of *Dumak* regiments, reference to orders issued for the guidance of other officers (Magistral & Vice) has been omitted altogether from the Fortresses.

(d) Obsolete rulings and orders also have been omitted from the Fortresses and certain important rulings which had been omitted have now been inserted.

(e) Extracts from the *Madras* army regulations of 1876 have been omitted and
