Dewan Bahadur, Inspector-General of Registration, to the Chief Secretary
to Government, dated Calicut, 23rd April 1895, No. 1101-T.

The inhabitants of the five villages noted in the margin have submitted petitions that their villages, which are now attached to the registration sub-district of Muthukulathur, in the Madura district, may be transferred to that of Kamudi, which latter sub-district was established under G.O., dated 27th July 1894, No. 1849,

- (1) Anaiyur.
- (2) Vendankottai.
- (3) Puliyanikulam (Devastanam).
- (4) Pammendal.
- (5) Karisalkulam (Pa).

Judicial. The petitioners allege that their villages are nearer to Kamudi than to Muthukulathur and that for proceeding to Muthukulathur they have to cross jungle streams and lakes, and that this inconvenience will be avoided if the villages are transferred to the Kamudi Sub-Registrar's office.

2. The District Registrar of Madura has reported that the hardships complained of are real and the transfer of the villages to Kamudi will promote the convenience of the public. Kamudi being the head-quarters of the Zemindari Tahsildar, the villagers who have to go to the revenue office frequently for various purposes will find it a great boon to be permitted to register their documents also at Kamudi. The number of documents relating to immoveable property situated in the five above-mentioned villages in the past year was only 64 and the work in both the Kamudi and Muthukulathur Sub-Registrars' offices will not be appreciably affected by the proposed transfer.

3. In these circumstances I have the honour to recommend that the Government may be pleased to sanction the transfer of the five villages to the Kamudi sub-district with effect from the 1st July 1895.

4. A draft notification giving effect to the proposed transfer is enclosed for the approval of Government and for publication in the Fort St. George and Madura District Gazettes.

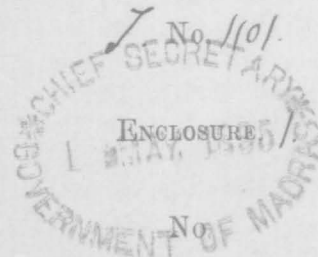
