Honorable Sir,

I am directed to forward

letter, dated 13th November, 1894, no 1322, and
its enclosure from the District Judge of
Godavari bringing to notice that the
Court of the District Munsif of Narasapur
is located in a building which besides
being incommodious and unsuitable for
a Court is in a condition of very bad
repair. The roof especially is in a bad
state. It sags seriously and some of the
rafters are decayed and have suffered
damage from white ants, so that the
expense of restoring it to a satisfactory
condition



Condition would be heavy, while the ventilation and lighting of all the rooms are very defective. The building appears to have been built as a dwelling house and was purchased by Government in 1863 for use by the Court.

2. Having regard to its dilapidated condition and its unsuitability for a Court-house, the District Judge proposes construction of a new building on the same site and the High Court supports his proposal. I am accordingly directed to request that His Excellency the Governor in Council will be pleased to sanction the construction of a new building and order the preparation of the necessary plans and estimates therefor after the type design is revised.
