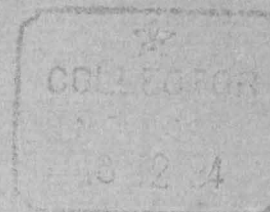

2. On the 26th November 1894 the Andakurpeth
Station house officer produced him before this court,
with a charge sheet charging him with committing
offences under sections 457-380 I. P. Code. The
accused having on enquiry appeared to be in an
unsound state of mind. I forwarded him for
observation & examination to the District Surgeon.
This officer, after observing him for about a
fortnight, has come to the conclusion that he is
of unsound mind & therefore incapable of making
his defence. After examining the District Surgeon
on the fact of his unsoundness. I stopped further
proceedings in this case under section 464 Criminal Procedure
Code. I now therefore beg to submit the papers noted
below for the orders of Government.
