In the case of consignments crossing the frontier by road or river, the articles must be made available for exhibition to the frontier Magistrate or other principal officer within six days of their reaching the frontier district, and before they leave British Territory.— Notification dated 25th November 1881, No. 1893, and G.O., dated 9th December 1881, No. 2532.

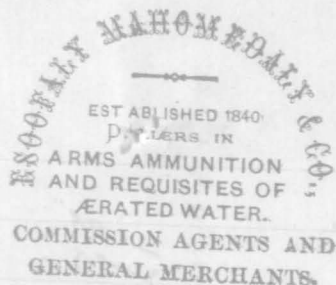
