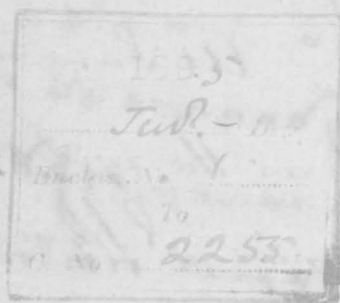

The humble petition of convict no: 1530, Nachi

Coimbatore Central Jail.

On hearing that the enemies were
robbing the crops in the field, my father went
there. They murdered my father and on my
going there, they tied me and brought this false
case against me. Four out of the witnesses
cited by me were not inquired in the Sessions
Court. The evidences of my mother and sister
were not considered. My statement was not
taken into consideration. As I am an enemy
to the Village Munsiff and as the witness for the
prosecution are my enemies, I humbly pray
Your Excellency to consider my case and
to pardon the sentence of death passed on me.

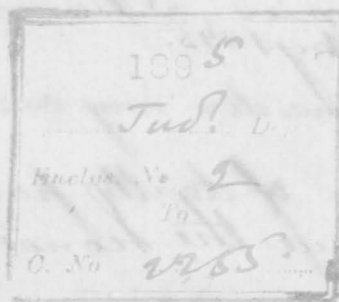
