READ—the following Proceedings of the Board of Revenue (Land Revenue), dated 26th March 1895, Mis. No. 1560 :—

Read—the following letter from J. H. A. TREMENHEERE, Esq., Collector of Bellary, to the Secretary to the Commissioners of Land Revenue, dated 14th February 1895, No. 126-Index :—

With reference to paragraph 3 of the Board's Proceedings, dated 23rd August 1894, No. 4718, Mis., I have the honour to state that a notice of the proposed transfer was published, in the District Gazette, dated 3rd November 1894, and objections were invited.

1. Bhairavunitippa.	4. Vyapalaparti.	2. Objection petitions were received from the marginally-noted six villages only. The chief objections are—
2. Kodihalli.	5. Yaradakera.	
3. Gundiganahalli.	6. Beluguppa.	

- (1) That Rayadrug is nearer to these villages than Kalyandrug.
- (2) There is no proper road to Kalyandrug and the existing one runs through hills and jungles.
- (3) The road is infested with robbers and journey is dangerous.
- (4) There are no chattrams for outsiders to halt.
- (5) There are no hotels.
- (6) The head-quarters of the district (Anantapur) are at a greater distance than the head-quarters of Bellary district.
- (7) The ryots will have to go to Penukonda for civil suits. This is a distant place and the journey is expensive.
- (8) As the District Judge's and the District Munsif's Courts as well as the Collector's and Divisional officer's are all located in Bellary, and as this is also a large mercantile centre, people coming here for one business are able to transact other business also simultaneously. This convenience does not exist if the villages are transferred to Kalyandrug.
- (9) The village of Hanakanahal with a beriz equal to that of many villages may be transferred in lieu of the above.

3. As regards objections 1 and 6 the difference in distance is not great, and does not exceed five miles in any case. Objections 4 and 5 are not true as the Tahsildar reports that there are four temples at Kalyandrug which provide sufficient accommodation for people and that there is also a hotel and more will be opened as the demand increases. Objections 2 and 8 are to some extent true, but every village cannot expect to have all conveniences. Objection 9 needs no consideration as the object of the transfer is to give a larger area to the Kalyandrug taluk.

4. There thus remain two objections Nos. 3 and 7 to be dealt with and these deserve some consideration. The establishment of Police ghauts at convenient distances on the road will remove danger from robbers and if the present civil jurisdiction of the Bellary District Munsif's Court is allowed to continue, there will be no inconvenience to the ryots of the villages proposed to be transferred to the Kalyandrug taluk.

5. Excepting the objections mentioned in the previous paragraph, there is no serious objection to the proposed transfer of the villages and the transfer may come into force from 1st April 1895.

6. Under these circumstances, a draft notification is herewith submitted for the approval of Government and for publication in the *Fort St. George Gazette*. The two hamlets—Vyapalaparti and Gundiganahalli—referred to in paragraph 1 of the Board's Proceedings quoted above have been included in the list. Their beriz is as follows:—

Read—also the following letter from J. H. A. TREMENHEERE, Esq., Collector of Bellary, to the Secretary to the Commissioners of Land Revenue, dated 15th March 1895, No. 232-Index:—

I have the honour to submit a revised draft notification specifying the boundaries of the villages to be transferred to Anantapur district as directed in Board's Reference on Sub-Register No. 556, dated 27th February 1895.

Resolution—dated 26th March 1895, Mis. No. 1560.

The papers read above will be submitted to Government with the request that the proposed transfers of 21 villages and the two hamlets of Gumenaghatta from the Rayadrug taluk, Bellary district, to the Kalyandrug taluk, Anantapur district, and of two villages from the Rayadrug taluk of the former district to the Anantapur taluk of the latter may be approved. The Board considers that the transfers may be made notwithstanding the objections raised by the ryots of the six villages mentioned in paragraph 2 of the first letter read above, provided the proposals made in paragraph 4 of the same letter are given effect to.

2. The revised draft notification received with the second letter read above does not show the two hamlets of Gumenaghatta and their boundaries. These have accordingly been inserted and the notification is herewith submitted for publication in the *Fort St. George Gazette*.
