with reference to G.O. 28 January 1895 No. 183, I have the honour to report that K. Kuv-holen, one of the two State Prisoners in the Central Jail, Coimbatore, is in Hospital under treatment for diabetes and the Medical officer has certified that he is unfit to make the journey to Madras. It appears to be uncertain whether the convict will be fit to travel within a reasonable time, but as the disease is understood to be of a chronic, rather than of an acute, character, it is probable that it will be possible to move him later. The patient is not seriously ill, but the effects of the fatigue of travelling and the depression likely to be produced by removal to a distance from his home are expected to be prejudicial.
